BILLING PROCEDURE

- As a matter of policy, our company follows the Wisconsin Lien Law process as a tool to protect yours and our interest as a material supplier to your customer's project. This process becomes a win win situation for both of us.
- With each new job, Zuern Building Products informs your customer that we are the material supplier for building products on their job. A "Subcontractor Identification Notice" sent to them in the mail accomplishes this. Although legally necessary to enforce a lien at a later date, this form is simply procedural at this point.
 - Our salesperson will be asking you for the name, current address, and job address as you start new jobs.
 - We will then send out a letter introducing ourselves as the building materials supplier with a brief explanation of the "Subcontractor Identification Notice."
 - "Subcontractor Identification Notice" will be sent certified mail per Wisconsin State Law, and your customer will be asked to sign for the envelope.
 - A "Subcontractor Identification Notice" will be a valuable tool to assist YOU and US if a disagreement should
 occur and funds are threatened to be withheld.
- Should funds be withheld, we will proceed with an "Intent to File a Construction Lien" to your customer.
- If the problem has not been resolved within 30 days from sending the "Intent to File a Construction Lien," we can now file the actual "Construction Lien" on the customer's property. Our experience has shown us that in most cases, customers and their financial lending institutions respond quicker to grievances and that money issues clear up faster when this procedure has been legally followed.
- Please refer to the enclosed pages for a sample of the "Subcontractor Identification Notice," sample letter and a schedule of our payment terms. If you should have questions regarding the application or questions for the Accounts Receivable Department, please refer to the contact list found on the next page.

TERMS

- Statements are processed on the last day of each month and mailed the following business day.
- Statements come due on the last day of the following month. Balances not paid after 30 days will accrue finance charges.
- Accounts over 60 days past due will be reviewed by management.
- In order to maintain an account, purchases at a minimum of \$5,000.00 per year are expected. Exemptions will be made for local municipalities, businesses, and churches/religious organizations. Anything under this amount we encourage you to use cash, check, or a credit card.

RETURNS

Under normal situations, inventoried items may be returned within 45 days without a return charge provided that they are in clean, saleable conditions and of reasonable quantities. Items that are special ordered and stocked by our vendors are subject to a return charge of up to 50% if our vendor approves a return. Special order items made to order, non-inventoried by our vendor, or pre-finished, cannot be returned for credit.

SPECIAL ORDER PRODUCTS

Product that has been special ordered, received, and remain at Zuern Building Products for a period of more than 30 days will be invoiced to the customer. Please understand in the height of the building season, Zuern Building Products experiences a shortage of space and damage to product increases with each handling. Zuern Building Products thanks you for your understanding of this policy.
