

PROJECT UPDATE

Puetz Road Intersection Work

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing WIS 100 from S. 60th Street to W. Saint Martins Road in the City of Franklin, Milwaukee County. Work is scheduled to be completed in fall 2025.

Beginning September 29, 2025:

Crews are scheduled to begin reconstructing the intersection of Puetz Road and WIS 100.

- The intersection will be closed to all traffic for approximately one month
- WIS 100 remains closed to all non-local traffic between 60th Street and Puetz Road. Motorists with destinations within the work zone will be directed to drive on the newly constructed WIS 100 driving lanes
- Motorists with destinations between Puetz Road and 92nd Street are encouraged to use Elm Court and 92nd Street to access WIS 100

Alternate Routes:

 Motorists are encouraged to use WIS 36 (Loomis Road),
County BB (Rawson Avenue) and WIS 241 (27th Street) to get around the closure

Puetz Road/WIS 100 Intersection Design

Following resident inquiries and requests, WisDOT has approved a new roadway design to improve safety at the intersection of WIS 100 and Puetz Road.

Safety upgrades include:

- Maintaining two lanes of traffic and a dedicated left turn lane on southbound WIS 100 through the intersection
- Gradually dropping a southbound driving lane on WIS 100 to streamline merging south of Puetz Road
- Extending the stop line for eastbound Puetz Road motorists to improve sight lines through the intersection





All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
